Meeting called to order by Chairman Glenn Wilson. Sal Landi was also present. The records of the February 11, 2009 meeting were accepted as read. Glenn reported he had a conversation with the town administrator on how to fill the third water/sewer commissioner position. Both Wilson & Landi agreed to appoint Robert Horn to fill this position until 2010, the remainder of the term. The commissioners reviewed the proposed recommendations by FST. They are scheduled to meet with Donald Bunker from FST in a public meeting on Thursday, March 26 at 1:00PM. The commissioners reviewed the list of delinquent water accounts, which are scheduled to be shut off on April 15. At this time Joan Putnam, representing the estate of Inez Wilson joined our meeting. She was inquiring why the estate was being billed when no water usage was being recorded. Commissioner Wilson advised her that as long as service was still available on the property, that bills would continue as a minimum charge. Wilson reminded her that in order to have water terminated, that the current bill would have to be current, and it would have to be shut off on or before April 15. After that date another quarter would be assessed, and that the billing coming out in April would also have to be current before any termination if she waits until after April 15. Putnam advised the commissioners that she would request the water to be terminated after cold weather leaves us. With nothing else to discuss at this time, Sal Landi made a motion, which was seconded by Wilson to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 8:29PM
