

BENNINGTON WATER/SEWER COMMISSIONERS
July 14, 2009

Meeting called to order at 6:45PM. Glenn was the only one present at this time. Terry Schnare arrived just as Glenn was getting started. He had questions about 9 Bible Hill Road. Commissioner Wilson stated that he would have to come before the board later this evening when more commissioners would be available. At just that time, commissioner Sal Landi arrived, which was 6:50PM. Commissioner Wilson filled commissioner Landi what had happened. The commissioners will discuss further in this meeting, and Commissioner Wilson will meet with him tomorrow when he does shut off's of water for the quarter. The minutes for June 9, 2009 were accepted as written. Commissioner Wilson made a couple of phone calls to past due accounts, all others will be terminated unless payment is received at the door before shut off. A review of the fence details for both Bible Hill and Starrett Road stated that the administrator had talked with selectmen Trow and road agent Gary Russell, and that the commissioners feel that the notes were incorrectly written, also that the commissioners feel that they should be making the final decision about such water/sewer projects. The commissioners did review a letter from High Bank Properties, LLC in reference to 9 Bible Hill Road. As stated earlier in this meeting, Terry Schnare had already left this meeting. The commissioners voted to check with Jim Cruthers to get an exact date when service was restored before making any further decisions. The commissioners were in receipt of paperwork for John Spanos appointment to be the third commissioner. Commissioner Wilson and Landi voted to appoint John Spanos the third commissioner, effective July 14, 2009. The commissioners filled out the paper work. Commissioner Wilson will be contacting John to see if he can come in on Saturday, July 18 to finish the process & get sworn in by the town clerk at that time. Commissioner Wilson stated that due to a budget freeze, as requested by all departments, the painting of the hydrants to meet NFPA status would be delayed until next year. With nothing else to discuss, Glenn made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Sal Landi. Meeting adjourned at 9:20PM.
