Jill Young called the meeting to order at 6:09 p.m.

Jill gave a list of the expenditures to Shelagh for review. The bill for the removal of trees at the Cemetery was reviewed. Five trees have been removed and the wood chipped.

Jill will contact the prison to schedule the prisoners to do spring clean up at the cemeteries. The Trustees will plan to use the facilities at the VFW to feed the prisoners when they are in town for work.

It was noted that both Jill Young and Karen Bartlett have been put on the ballot for the March election. Jill will be running for a three-year position and Karen will be running for a one-year position.

The budget has been submitted and has not changed from the previous year. The Trustees plan to get loam and grass seed for repairs on both cemeteries in the spring.

The Trustees are looking at a grant offered from funds available from the moose plates. The possibility of a computer for records and acid free paper were discussed. The Trustees will research the grant further.

As the March Trustee meeting is scheduled for the same day as the Town election, the Trustees agreed to move the meeting to March 6, 2012 at 6:00 p.m.
