Chairman Rose called the meeting to order at 7:37 p.m.

The minutes of the June 11, 2012 meeting were reviewed and accepted as written.

A letter was received from the Dollar General withdrawing their request for a variance from the ZBA. Chairman Rose made a motion to drop the current application due to the incomplete application and lapse in time. Susan Smith seconded the motion and all were in favor.

Two wetlands permit applications have been received. The Monadnock Paper Mill is installing a new heating system and the towns of Bennington and Antrim have applied to replace the bridge in North Bennington.

Chairman Rose has received a call from the owner of Mike's Towing concerning the possibility of a business in town. The business would have two tow trucks and a holding yard with low usage. Most of the business would be held off the property. It was noted that property has been purchased on Birch Glen Road on a class 6 road. A business plan will be submitted.

The Planning Board has received submissions for the Master Plan from the Energy Committee, Transfer Station and Historical Society. The submissions were reviewed. Chairman Rose will contact Lisa Murphy from Southwest to discuss how much information should be included in the Master Plan. A letter will be sent to the remaining Department Heads and Committee Chairmen requesting their reports with a deadline of September 1, 2012.

There being no other business at hand, the meeting was adjourned at 8:35 p.m.
