BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Minutes of the Meeting – February 13, 2013

Selectmen Steven Osienski, James Cleary and Jeffrey Rose were present as well as Administrator Denise French. The meeting was called to order at 6:07 p.m.

From 6:16 p.m. until 7:20 p.m. the Selectmen unanimously voted to conduct business in Nonpublic Session under RSA 91-A:3II(c). Present were Selectmen Osienski, Cleary and Rose, Administrator French, Peter Martel and Sam Cohen. The group discussed allegations of inappropriate dialogue. No decisions were made.

In other matters the Selectmen took the following action:

- Reviewed and approved the Selectmen's February 5, 2013 Minutes.
- Reviewed and approved February 6 and 13, 2013 Payroll and Accounts Payable Registers.
- Heard a report that an Acre Street resident has continuing concerns about water in their cellar. Selectman Cleary volunteered to discuss the matter with Water/Sewer Superintendent James Cruthers.
- Heard a report of a minor motor vehicle accident between the Bennington Rescue vehicle and a Bennington Highway truck during the height of "Storm Nemo". Minor damage was sustained to the roll-up door of the Rescue.
- Should the State declare a Disaster Declaration for "Nemo" the Town could be the recipient of approximately \$14,000.
- Reviewed the January Police Statistics.
- Heard a report from Jim Cleary that he had been solicited to interview the three final candidates for hire as the Superintendent of the Contoocook Valley School District.
- Discussed the prior evening's Regional Selectmen's follow-up meeting in Greenfield; Antrim, Frankestown and Hancock Town Officials were absent. The next scheduled meeting is March 5th.

The meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
