BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Minutes of the Meeting – February 4, 2014

Selectmen James Cleary, Jeffrey Rose and Steven Osienski were present as well as Administrator Denise French. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

The Selectmen took action of the following matters:

- Reviewed and approved the January 9, 2014 Payroll Register as well as the February 4, 2014 Payroll and Accounts Payable Registers.
- Agreed to have the former Bryer property on Old Greenfield Road, M7/L37-1, logged by a firm who is harvesting timber on an abutting lot. Selectmen Rose and Osienski appointed Selectman Cleary as the Board's representative to arrange for the timber cut.
- Unanimously voted to request additional funds of \$66,000 from NHDOT for TEP2. Should the TEP2 project be eligible for this infusion of money the Town will be responsible for a 20% Grant match in the amount of \$13,200.
- Agreed that an employee could carry over four days of their 2013/2014 vacation allotment into April as long as the time is used by April 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Agreed that Town Hall could be used for a weekly dance class for children as long as the Instructor provides a discounted fee for those participants who are Bennington residents.
- Voted that the 2013 Town Report cover will be dedicated to long-time public servant John French; also gracing the cover will be retired Library Trustee Eunice Blanchard. Both residents passed in 2013.
- On behalf of the Board, Selectman Osienski agreed to prepare the 2013 Selectmen's Message for the Town Report.

The meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m. when the Selectmen moved to Pierce Elementary School for the Deliberative Session.
