Meeting called to order at 7:05pm

Peter M shared proposals from Margaret Dillon for the Railroad Station and Ted Stiles for the Pump House, as well as updates of grants and the Railroad Station/VFW. NH Preservation Grant received; Dave Drasba of Sculley firm in Keene will be contracted to do the work; Margaret Dillon's proposal is intended for us to use to write the NEGEF Grant, so she can make weatherization and heating recommendations for the project.

Dave will re-look at his numbers for the pump house based on Ted Stiles' proposal, and we agreed to ask Margaret Dillon for a fee for her doing a proposal for the pump house. Peter M will ask her, sending photos and dimensions.

Molly suggested taking on some low hanging fruit at the library, specifically the rim joist (perimeter where the floor meets the top of the foundation).

Peter M will ask Jim Cruthers, Antrim Water Department Superintendent, about what he knows about the minimum allowable temperature for the Pump House and the various chemicals and equipment.

Peter M shared photos and a little information about the Solar Tractor project, as well as some work regarding efforts to work with other regional energy committees.

The next meeting is on October 2nd.
