BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Minutes of the Meeting – April 8, 2015

Selectmen James Cleary, Jeffrey Rose and Steven Osienski were present as well as Administrator Denise French. Also attending the meeting was Monadnock Ledger-Transcript reporter David Blumenthal. The meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m.

From 6:18 p.m. until 7:07 p.m. the Selectmen met in Nonpublic Session under RSA 91-A:3II(d). Present were Selectmen Cleary, Rose and Osienski, Administrator French, John J. Cronin, III and Monsignor Gerald Belanger. The group discussed vacant property owned by Divine Mercy Parish. No decisions were made.

From 7:24 p.m. until 7:37 p.m. the Selectmen met in Nonpublic Session under RSA 91-A:3II(d). Present were Selectmen Cleary, Rose and Osienski as well as Administrator French. The group continued discussion relevant to vacant property owned by Divine Mercy Parish. No decisions were made.

The Selectmen took action on the following matters:

- Reviewed and approved April 1, 2015 Selectmen's Minutes.
- Reviewed and approved April 8, 2015 Payroll and Accounts Payable Registers.
- Heard a report that Jason Lepine's background check has been completed. An Oath of Office was signed and administered for part-time employment. A second Oath of Office will be signed and administered to Officer Lepine ahead of his full-time employment with Bennington Police Department which will begin May 4th. A "pinning ceremony" is scheduled for April 29th.
- Signed were an Intent to Excavate for M3/L1; Gravel Tax Warrant for M11/L16; Yield Tax Warrant for M17/L35, 34B and 34; and the annual Federal Surplus Property Agreement.
