The meeting was called to order at 6:06 p.m.

The minutes of the June 9, 2015 meeting were reviewed and accepted as written.

Joshua shared a picture of a blue grave marker located in Evergreen Cemetery from the 1800's that was made of zinc.

Bethany Craig approached the Trustees to find out if there would be room in her plot for more burials. She presently has the cremains of two small children there. She will have space for other cremains and will not need to purchase an additional plot.

It was noted that New England Grave Stone Services has been paid and the fees have been taken from the Catholic Charities funding. The Trustees may hire additional work without putting it back out to bid. Joshua will arrange for the additional work to be done.

It was noted that Mr. Gagnon has received his pay for cemetery maintenance.

The status of the new letter for the Sunnyside Cemetery gate is unknown. Karen will contact Jill for an update.

Karen and Joshua discussed the need of work on the cemetery records. It was agreed that the August meeting will be used as a work session unless there is something more pending at the time.

Joshua noted that he feels that \$350 is too low of a price for a cemetery lot. He would like to discuss a price increase to be more in line with other towns.

As there was no other business at hand, the meeting was adjourned at 6:52 p.m.
