Minutes of the Meeting- February 14, 2017

Chairman Bartlett called the meeting to order at 6:51 p.m.

The minutes of the January 10, 2017 meeting were reviewed and accepted as written.

Karen noted that she has not contacted Greenfield yet to inquire about the process of replacing their cemetery fence.

The Trustees discussed the snow bank that has been plowed into the gate and fencing at Sunnyside Cemetery. The gate has been pushed open and the snow is piled up against it. Once the work has been done on the gate, the Trustees will speak to the Highway Department about plowing so that it will not damage the gate.

Joshua reported that he has completed the informational book for Evergreen Cemetery. Joshua suggested that the Trustees start a summer project of setting up a file for each lot in Sunnyside Cemetery. He will get estimates for scanning the pages of the book and putting it in digital form.

It was noted that the March meeting will canceled as the Town election is scheduled for the same day.

Karen reported that she spoke to a gentleman who is related to the Coffin family about lots Evergreen Cemetery. He will most likely visit the Trustees in April. The Trustees can find out if he has any ties to Bennington at that time.

It was noted that Karen spoke to the Cemetery warrant article at the Deliberative session.

The Trustees discussed possibilities for cemetery fencing in the future. They are looking at many possibilities.

As there was no other business at hand, the meeting was adjourned at 7:28 p.m.
