Chairman Belcher called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m.

The minutes of the October 10, 2017 meeting were reviewed and accepted as written.

It was noted that the Road Agent has indicated that he is too busy to remove the fencing at Sunnyside Cemetery as requested by the Cemetery Trustees.

The rules and regulations for the cemeteries were discussed shortly. It was agreed on that the rules need to prevent loopholes and be easily understood. As all the Trustees were not present, the work on the rules and regulations were tabled until the next Cemetery Trustee meeting. It was suggested that a highlighted version of the final rules and regulations be created to be used as an overview page. It was noted that there is a need to be able to enforce cemetery rules. The Trustees will recommend possible fines to the Board of Selectmen.

In other business, it was noted that Mr. Kaufold has been paid for his stone work.

The Cemetery Trustees have received two bids for up-coming stone work. The job was awarded to Gravestone Services of New England. Chairman Belcher will contact the other bidder to thank them for their interest.

The Trustees reviewed the lot transfers that the Office Staff found in the safe.

It was noted that there will be no December Cemetery Trustee Meeting.

As there was no other business at hand, the meeting was adjourned at 7:27 p.m.
