BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Minutes of the Meeting – March 28, 2018

Selectmen James Cleary, Mark Mackesy and David Hardwick Sr. were present as well as Administrator Denise French. The meeting was called to order at 6:02 p.m.

Police Chief Bret Sullivan and Sergeant Jason LePine introduced themselves to newly elected Selectman David Hardwick before discussing items of mutual interest with the Board. Chief Sullivan reported an impending amicable resignation from a part-time police officer.

The Selectmen acted on the following matters:

- Reviewed and approved the Selectmen's March 21, 2018 Minutes.
- Reviewed and approved the March 29, 2018 Payroll and Accounts Payable Registers.
- Heard a report that the final shipment of LED street lights were installed this date.
- Heard a report of the Water/Sewer Commissioners' meeting with Henry Underwood from Southwest Region Planning Commission and administrative staff in preparation of the Asset Management Program.
- Tabled an agenda item discussion under RSA 91-A:3II(c).
- Received an invitation to a community conversation regarding transportation options for rural residents who don't drive or have access to transportation as well as discussion about 2018 Coordinated Plan for Community Transportation. Call to Action meetings will be held in Peterborough April 17th, 7:30-9:00 a.m. at Monadnock Community Hospital as well as in Keene April 18th, 5:00-6:30 p.m. at Home, Healthcare, Hospice and Community Services.
- Adopted the Resolution to Enter Primex Property & Liability Contribution Assurance Program by accepting the offer of the New Hampshire Public Risk Management Exchange (Primex) to enter into its Property & Liability Contribution Assurance Program as of March 28, 2018, and to be contractually bound to all of the terms and conditions of Primex risk management pool membership during the term of the Property & Liability Contribution Assurance Program. The coverage provided by Primex in each year of membership shall be as then set forth in the Coverage Documents of Primex.
- The Board reviewed/approved and signed the following documents:
