Meeting started at 6:10

Approval of the minutes from January 3, 2018 were moved (1st Molly; 2nd Peter M) and unanimously accepted as originally submitted.

There was discussion as to why Affinity, who originally presented a proposal for the LED street light project, didn't submit a bid. Peter M offered to contact Affinity as to re why they didn't bid.

David verbally shared an LED project status update he received from Peter E via email. There have been some delays but the grant will still cover half the cost, up to a grant total of \$5,000. Per Molly work could begin as early as next week, though a complete accounting of the funds may take a while after the work is complete.

Molly shared solar information regarding her contact with Go Solar New England, Granite State Solar (of Bow) & ReVision Energy; all expressed a willingness to come and meet with us. Go Solar indicated a need for electric bills. Considerations for roof orientations, roof slope, and trees are factors in siting. We discussed various locations, various factors and possibilities.

Peter M will get latest electric bills from the office for the meetings with solar installers. Molly will seek 3 possible meeting times with each of the above mentioned installers, and will then inform us of these options so a meeting can be scheduled and properly posted.
