Chairman Belcher called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. held at the Sunnyside Cemetery.

Bethany Craig was made a voting member for the meeting.

The budget was reviewed noting that all of the expense for grounds keeping is for the labor of the grounds keeper. The perpetual care expenses have been reported but will not be available until the end of the year.

The Trustees walked the cemetery noting work to be done in Sunnyside Cemetery. A list was made to include filling holes, grinding stumps dealing with a bee hive, and removal of some large tree limbs. It was noted that all tree work should be done at one time if possible. More loam is also needed at Evergreen Cemetery. Other items that were discussed were, signage for the cemetery, the possibility of moving some of the fencing from the back of the cemetery to the front area, and the need to have Mr. Chicoine on the account at Edmund's Hardware Store so that he may charge needed supplies.

It was noted that bids will be needed for more tree removal. Mr. Chicoine will mark the trees that will need to be removed.

In other business Karen Belcher made a motion to elect Joshua Segal as Chairman of the Cemetery Trustees. Bethany Craig seconded the motion and all were in favor.

The minutes of the October 8, 2019 meeting were reviewed and accepted as written.

The minutes of the November 12, 2019 meeting were reviewed and accepted as written.
