Chairman Segal called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

The minutes of the August 11, 2020 meeting were reviewed and accepted as written.

The Cemetery Trustees reviewed the bills for the care of the cemeteries. It was noted that they will be over the budgeted amount for supplies, but under in other areas. The Trustees have been using interest funds from the perpetual care funds to off-set mowing costs. Only the interest of the perpetual care fund may be used and some of the accounts have been zeroed out.

Karen reported that George Chicoine has looked at the fencing in the back of Sunnyside Cemetery with the thought of using it to replace damaged fencing in the front areas. The fencing is rootbound and George was not able to move it. It is possible that there might be some fencing panels in the old shed at Evergreen Cemetery. It was suggested that the Trustees purchase fencing sections to replace the missing ones. It was noted that signage is needed to remind the public that there is no sledding in the cemeteries.

In other business, the tree work was put on hold as Melissa is still working on getting quotes. Evergreen Cemetery has been improved with the purchase of loam. George Chicoine has done a wonderful job filling in potholes and gullies. It was noted that Joshua Segal has been asked to attend the Sunnyside Cemetery on Friday with the 4<sup>th</sup> grade class for a math class.

As there was no other business at hand, the meeting was adjourned at 6:47 p.m.
