Motion by Chairman Cleary to amend and recalculate the default budget, the changes are a result of contractual obligations such as insurances, raises and other obligations required by statutory law. The amount of the changes equal \$67,604.00 – this increases the default budget to One Million, Eight Hundred

Thirty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Seven dollars (\$1,839,457.00).

Seconded by Selectman James.

**Discussion:** Chairman Cleary explained the reason for this meeting was due to a clerical error. This meeting corrects the error, the Department of Revenue Administration and Town Counsel has been notified and provided direction. This meeting should correct the error.
