Selectmen noted these comments and agree with the Budget Committee.

- Truck & Backhoe Selectmen discussed getting seat covers and undercoating both new pieces of equipment. Unanimously voted (3-0) to have the Town Administrator notify the Road Agent to get in touch with the dealers and get seat covers and to get undercoating done as soon as possible.
