

**Bennington Water/Sewer Commissioners' Meeting**  
**June 11, 2024 at 4:00 PM**  
**Meeting Minutes**

Present: Dennis McKenney, Tyler Howe, Melissa Clark, Residents: Daniel Messina and David Burrows.

Tyler opened the meeting at 4:00 pm.

Daniel Messina (31 S. Bennington Road) was before the Board to request a hook up to the town's sewer line. Tyler already walked the site with Zack Andersen (Zack works for Antrim Water/Sewer). Tyler advised Messina that he will be required to install a pump station, as well as obtain a DOT Road Permit. Elevation from the manhole to the driveway isn't enough. Tyler also advised that Messina will need to obtain a permit from Antrim as they do the tap and inspection. Messina was advised to call Antrim to see what needs to be done for the pump house. Messina then informed the Board that Meridian is doing the Plot Plan. Tyler advised Messina that Meridian will be able to advise him on everything.

David Burrows (6 Old Greenfield Road) was before the Board to request a hook up to the town's sewer line. Tyler advised that Burrows will not need a pump station as he is 8 ft from top of grade. Tyler advised Burrows that he will need a cleanout from the top of the driveway. Burrows will need to do a permit with Antrim for the tap and the inspection. Burrows advised that the 50 y/o copper line has been problematic and that he plans on replacing it. He asked questions regarding that and Tyler advised him that he will need to talk to Zack about that.

**Other:** Tyler advised he was told there is a leak on the cemetery line that runs from 47 through the Craig's property. Tyler advised Matt Miller to label the line and shut it off. This is an annual issue. Tyler advised they will need to drill from 47 in order to get rid of the issue.

Nothing further, Dennis made a motion to adjourn at 4:20pm.
