6:15 - Fire Chief, Zack Andersen - Selectmen have indicated that they have not heard

anything negative since the change of Fire Chief has taken place. They are happy with

Zack and are prepared to sign an appointment after Town Meeting.

New Fire Truck - Zack reported that the lettering for the new truck was ordered today

and it will be cheaper than originally quoted. The truck is scheduled for delivery this

week. A brief discussion as to dedication of the new truck followed. No decisions were

made about that at this time.

Old Fire Truck – Explaining how the bid process works, Chief Andersen indicated he

has had two hits on the old truck. One from Ohio the other from Kansas. These

inquiries will be followed up on. The old truck is all switched and being winterized. It

will be parked at the highway garage and hopefully will sell quickly.

New Members – Two new people have come forward and are interested in joining

the Fire Department. Theresa Daniels and Jack (John) Plourde. Both will be

considered.

Gas – Zack asked Selectmen for permission to switch from Air Gas to Granite Industrial

The cost is significantly less. A brief discussion followed, a credit

application was provided for the town to complete and return.

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Motion by Chairman Cleary to authorize Chief Andersen to switch from Air Gas to

Granite Industrial Gases, Inc. Seconded by Selectmen James & Parisi. Motion passed

3-0.

Boiler – Chief Andersen reported the boiler at the Fire Station died and needed some

work, Andersen presented an invoice for payment. Discussion followed how to pay

for the invoice either building maintenance or with the Expendable Trust. This will

likely be paid out of the maintenance budget, it is maintenance.

EMT Apprenticeship – Chief Andersen discussed how the program works. It is

required to pay the EMT \$14.00/hour, once they have completed the course the State

will reimburse ½ the cost. However, the EMT must continue to make \$14.00/hour

after becoming certified.

Selectmen thanked Chief Andersen for the update and assured him they are happy

with how things are going, they are prepared to appoint him as the Chief after March

11, 2025.

6:30 - Rhubarb Festival - Melissa Clark came before the board to discuss the Rhubarb

Festival. Melissa indicated she will be working to see that there is another successful

Rhubarb Festival in 2025. Discussion followed regarding the Festival. No decisions

were made at this time.
