It was noted that the filing cabinet in the office contains the deeds for the cemetery. Karen has spent many hours updating the files and putting all information for each lot together. In other business, it was noted that the first billing for mowing and cemetery care has been received and submitted. As there is poison ivy at Sunnyside Cemetery, it was sprayed at no cost to the town. It was noted that there is also poison ivy at Evergreen Cemetery.
