Discussion 19 Starrett Road Abatement. Resident has been in touch with Cathy regarding a leak that occurred back in the fall of 2025 causing a significant increase in her bill. The matter was resolved in the fall. The board agreed to abate a portion of the sewer bill. Cathy will let the resident know tomorrow.

**Meters and outstanding bills due:** Jeremy will draft a letter to the residents who have not had their meter changed. He will be including additional costs the will incur as the next step is to shut off their water. After discussing fees, Melissa made a motion to make the shut fee be \$100.00 and the fee to turn water back on will be \$100.00 as well. Motion seconded by Jon.

**183 Bible Hill Road:** Resident told Melissa that the water is pink, sledge-like, and smells very strongly like chlorine. Jeremy advised he will get in touch with the resident to set up a time do a water test at the residence.

**Old Stagecoach Road Subdivision:** discussion about adding lines to the subdivision. Matt Depres (developer) is responsible for paying for time and materials to get the job done. Jeremy will send a bill to us in order for us to add to it.

**Flushing Hydrants:** Jeremy advised he will be flushing hydrants in Bennington the week of May 19, 2026.
